Hopefully we have now had the worst of the winter weather and can look forward to sunnier times.

On local matters, the annual levy is due from April 1st and all plot holders will receive a statement shortly after that date. There is a note accompanying this Newsletter providing further information on this matter. In essence, the charge will be £190 discounted to £170 per household if either the amount is paid in full by 21st April or a standing order set up by the same date. Thus for the second successive year the levy has been reduced.

We have had requests from residents to split the levy amount into equal monthly amounts and in the light of this we have arranged for the standing orders to be £17 each month for 10 months – provided that the orders are set up to commence by 21st April and there are no levy arrears. A form for this purpose will be issued with the levy statements.

Mothers Day: Sunday 22nd March – Lorraine has organised a four course meal from 1:30pm to 6:30pm in the resident's lounge. There is an excellent menu including tomato soup, king prawns, tuna steak, chicken, lamb and various desserts. The event is subject to demand and it is essential that a £5 non-refundable deposit is paid as soon as possible, certainly by 15th March at the latest. The cost is £12.95 per head and is free for children under 4.
