The charity auction was especially exciting with bidders outdoing each other and thanks to the participants raised an outstanding amount for the Hospice.

A special mention to the team who organise the **Dementia disco's** which provide important social interaction for those who are afflicted by this condition. There is no better illustration of community spirit and a great example of what we can all achieve to help others.

The Christmas fair took place on 16th November with 21 artisan stalls in attendance (several with us for the first time) providing gift ideas for Christmas, cakes, hot food, tombola and representatives from local charities.

These events are organised by the **Social Group** and are growing in popularity with the footfall increasing each time. Planning is underway for a Spring fair in May.
