We have had many requests for this activity to be restored, and the kitchen has been renovated and set out with a range of new equipment that will be flexible to meet different types of food offerings including main courses and bar snacks.

Our aim is to provide a range of traditional dishes that will hopefully satisfy all tastes without over extravagance using quality ingredients at a cost that will not break the bank. The menu will be varied from week to week and will include seasonal dishes. Our bar prices are also very competitive.

We will have a standard children's menu with the option of a half adult portion with a dessert and drink as a meal deal at a very reasonable cost of £6.95.

Each week the menu will be sent out via direct email and placed on the club notice board and judging by the take up of the last 5 weeks booking is essential to avoid disappointment as we can only cater for a certain number of guests at each service. Walk-in guests on the night can only be accommodated if space is available.

Reservations can be made via email office@ladybridgepark.co.uk or via telephone or at reception during opening hours. It will be greatly appreciated if your group can confirm their menu choice at the time of booking to avoid food waste and maintain competitive pricing. The service time will commence at 17-30 to 19-30.

If you have not registered your email address, then please contact the office via email or by phone to be kept fully informed. The bar staff will take orders, and payment will be through the club tills, and your food will be served to your table.

This is a great way to relax into the weekend in familiar surrounding no driving or taxi's catching up with friends and neighbours.

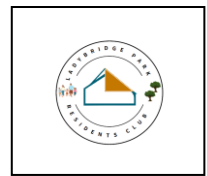

After feedback from concerned Residents regarding last year's event we have decided to introduce a ticketing system to address the issues and comply with Health and Safety practice.

The event will continue to be **free of charge to Residents and their invited guests** however **ALL** guests must be accompanied by the host Resident who will be entirely responsible for their conduct and safety.

All Children under the age of 16 must be **supervised at all times** by an appropriate adult.

Abusive and disruptive behaviour towards anyone including the staff and stewards will not be tolerated and may result in the perpetrators being asked to leave.

It is obvious that a bonfire and firework display is not without risk however small and we would ask that everyone wears appropriate clothing (hats, gloves, eye protection etc as they decide necessary) and observe the restricted areas which will be indicated by safety barriers. We do not wish to spoil the enjoyment of the event and the measures we are putting in place are designed to ensure that everyone is able to feel comfortable and fully enjoy themselves.

We will have one entry point to the club on the evening via a stewarded gate outside accessed from the Calderbrook Road entrance adjacent to the bonfire. All other entry points including the main doors will be closed.

Residents will be required to pass through the entrance with their guests showing the attached completed pass. Further copies can be obtained from the club reception.

NON residents will be charged £5 for Adults and £3 for Children up to 16 years of age however a group family ticket will cost no more than £16-00.

We have arranged for a catering van to be parked close to the entry point where hot snacks can be purchased. A children's sweet stall will also be sited outside.

We hope that you will appreciate the measures put in place and hope for good weather and an enjoyable and safe event.
